

**“Giving Tuesday 2022”  
Prize Draw Contest**

**RULES AND REGULATIONS**

- 1 This prize draw (the “**Contest**”) is conducted by the Chinese Canadian Museum Society of British Columbia (“**CCMSBC**”) to thank individuals who made a donation between November 29, 2022 to December 2, 2022.
- 2 The Contest is open to individuals aged 19 and over who are ordinarily resident in British Columbia. The Contest is not open to employees, directors or officers of CCMSBC.
- 3 To enter the contest, eligible Participants must:
  - (a) Have made a donation to CCMSBC between November 29, 2022 to December 2, 2022.
  - (b) Provide their contact information.
  - (c) Answer a skill-testing question to claim a prize.
- 4 No purchase necessary. No more than one (1) entry may be submitted per individual.
- 5 Those that comply with entry conditions will be entered into a draw to win a \$20 gift card from Kam Wai Dim Sum (the “**Prize**”) presented by CCMSBC at 27 East Pender Street, Vancouver, BC, V6A 1S9 (the “**Exhibit**”).
- 6 Under no circumstances will CCMSBC award a Prize other than in accordance with these rules. If entry is obtained irregularly or fraudulently, or if a Participant does not comply with these rules, their participation will be automatically void and no Prize will be awarded. The decisions of CCMSBC in relation to correct completion of the draw entry and compliance with rules of entry will be final and binding on all participants.
- 7 Draw will be conducted on or about December 9, 2022 and winning participant will be contacted. Prize may be claimed at 27 East Pender Street, Vancouver BC, V6A 1S9. Prize must be accepted as awarded. Prize may not be substituted or exchanged in whole or in part for its cash value by CCMSBC.
- 8 Prize must be redeemed at the Exhibit on or before the expiration date. CCMSBC is not responsible for loss, theft or misplacement of the Prize, or failure to redeem a Prize before expiry. Replacement Prize will not be provided under any circumstances.
- 9 CCMSBC is not responsible and accepts no liability whatsoever for any harm, loss or injury incurred by a Participant in any way arising from, or in connection with, the redemption of a Prize and the consumption of any consumables purchased therewith. Participants hereby irrevocably release CCMSBC and its directors, officers, employees, agents and representatives from any liability in connection with the Contest.

- 10 CCMSBC reserves the right to cancel, terminate, or suspend this Contest, at its sole discretion, if for any reason the Contest is not capable of being completed as planned, including but not limited to technical failure, computer virus or bug, unauthorized human intervention, fraud or any other occurrence or cause beyond its control that corrupts or adversely affects the administration, security, fairness or normal operation of the Contest.
- 11 The Contest is subject to all applicable Federal, Provincial and local laws, as well as the rules adopted in view of said laws. The personal information provided to enter the Contest will be used by CCMSBC only to administer the Contest, and for no other reason. CCMSBC will not transfer personal information to any third-party and will destroy and delete such information after the Contest comes to an end.
- 12 By participating in the Contest and submitting a complete entry, you agree:
  - (a) to be bound by these Rules and the decisions of CCMSBC for the administration of the Contest;
  - (b) to release and hold harmless CCMSBC, its affiliates, subsidiaries, and independent contractors, and their respective directors, officers, employees, agents and representatives including advertising and promotion agencies, from any and all liability for claims/damages including, but not limited to, claims/damages for personal injury or property damage with respect to acceptance, possession or use or misuse of the Prize or participation in the Contest; and
  - (c) to permit CCMSBC to use your name, photograph, image or any likeness, voice or declarations for advertising or publicity purposes without any additional compensation.
